Defining a Continuum

The phrase “a continuum of services for our Gifted population”, references offering a challenging curriculum for those identified as Gifted in grades K-12. While there are a variety of options appropriate to serve children who have been identified as gifted, the school district strives to offer each child the most appropriate academic challenge for his or her academic growth.

What does it look like?

Our district offers growth strategies within each grade level to challenge your young student. The district as a whole offers such strategies as acceleration, cluster grouping, curriculum compacting, differentiated curriculum, and enrichment.


Within the elementary school setting (grades 1-3), students will specifically receive Primary Education Thinking Skills programming (P.E.T.S.) which places emphasis on convergent and divergent thinking skills. The upper elementary grade levels will receive STEAM extension programming which will allow exploration in Science-Technology-Engineering-Arts-and Mathematics. Regardless of the grade level, there are extension options waiting to be explored.

In addition, K-12, your child will receive curriculum which has been differentiated by his/her classroom teacher accordingly in all areas of identification.

The Junior High and High School carry on the tradition of excellence offering programming such as Humanities courses, Technology Integration, Agricultural Science and Business, Dual Enrollment, Post-Secondary Enrollment Options (PSEO) and Credit Flex opportunities. Additional STEAM extension opportunities will be available for the secondary level as well.

The academic growth of our students is forefront in our efforts. Continued development of a Gifted Continuum of Services is yet another avenue of opportunity to expand student horizons.
