Timeline of the Americas

Using the dates below, create a vertical or horizontal timeline of the events that lead to the English 13 Colonies.

1733: English had established 13 colonies along east coast of North America

1521: Cortes defeats the Aztecs

1590: Lost Colony of Roanoke is settled

1607: Jamestown is formed by the English settlers in Virginia- first permanent settlement

1733: Georgia, the 13th colony, is established

1492: Columbus reaches the Americas

1608: Samuel de Champlain founds Quebec while in search of Northwest Passage

1682: William Penn establishes Pennsylvania

1621: Pilgrims and Wampanoag celebrate the good harvest, the first Thanksgiving

1533: Pizarro's army defeated the Incans

1535: New Spain is established, present day Mexico City was begun

1619: House of Burgesses formed
